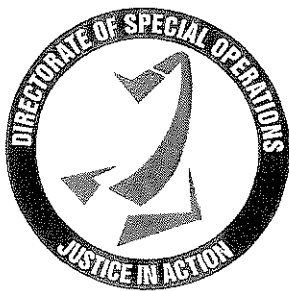

INVITATION FOR AN INTERVIEW

Your meeting and conversation with the National Director of Public Prosecutions, on Saturday 11 November 2006, refer.

As advised, the DSO is presently conducting an investigation under section 28(1) of the NPA Act into the offences of fraud, corruption, drug-trafficking, murder, money-laundering and racketeering.

This investigation which commenced on 28 March 2006 and has since been converted and extended in law, respectively on 28 June 2006 and 4 September 2006, relates to persons such as Messrs G Agliotti, C Nassif, P Stemmet and S Parapas, amongst others.

During the course of this investigation, reference has been made to you, in such a context, that some clarification is necessary.

We therefore extend an invitation to you, to submit to an interview on these and related aspects. This invitation flows from your expressed willingness to cooperate in the resolution of this matter.

The issues we wish to canvass with you, include the following:

- The handling of the criminal investigation into Randburg, CAS 42/1/2003, following an alleged report to you of Mr G Agliotti's involvement.
- Your relationship with Mr G Agliotti, and your comments/responses to certain notes in his diary and other documents.
- The connection between the investigation into the Kebble murder and certain aspects of the DSO's investigation referred to above.
- Whether Messrs Agliotti, Stemmet, Kebble, Nassif and Papparas, were registered / unregistered police informants/sources and the documentary evidence in support thereof, as well as payments made to any of the affected individuals.
- Your knowledge of any disbursements of funds from former special purpose structures like Misty Mountains Pty (Ltd) and Spring Lights Pty (Ltd), by JCI.
- Other matters that can become more pertinent by the time the interview takes place.

It will be helpful to avail relevant documents to us on this occasion, that can explain certain positions or facts, you wish us to consider.

Whilst you are under no obligation to participate in this interview, it will require an affirmation or the oath, will be mechanically recorded, and will have the usual implications of being made with prejudice and truthfully.

To this end, you can identify a suitable person to assist with the necessary arrangements and be legally represented, should you accept the invitation.

The ultimate purpose of the interview would be to determine your status and input in the continuation of this investigation.

I must appeal for absolute confidentiality for obvious reasons.
